

RULES

- *The ENTIRE boat must be built from brown corrugated cardboard & duct tape. No surfboard style boats.
- *No pre-treated, waxed cardboard allowed. No waterproofing mixtures.
- *Only seams and joints may be taped not the entire structure.
- *Paddles must be constructed of cardboard and duct tape only.
- *No legs, hands, or feet may be used to propel the boat.
- *One paddle per person per boat. No more than two people to pilot the boat.
- *To qualify the captain and co-captain must be IN the boat at the finish.
- *Boats may not exceed 8 feet in length and 4 feet in width.
- *The crew compartment CANNOT be enclosed as to interfere with escape.
- *Children under the age of 8 must wear a flotation device.
- *Decorations may only be made with permanent markers on the cardboard.
- *Each team must remove their entire boat and any boat remains from the water and put them in the dumpster.

PRIZES

1st & 2nd Place

- *fastest boat in each age division (determined by number of entries)
- oldest crew member will determine the team's division

Titanic Award

- *the boat that sinks in the most spectacular fashion

Pride of the Pool

- *the most creative, most attractive boat
