- IV. Amy Crist updated us about the 2019 Pool season. High Board is cracked and needs to be replaced. Amy has board approval to buy a board as it is within her budget. There had been 68 average attendance with 168 highest attendance so far. Lessons start Monday 17<sup>th</sup> for the first session. 2<sup>nd</sup> session is in July. They will have a Movie by the Pool.
- V. Jeremy moved, and Katie seconded to pay the cost of lifeguard training to be spread out over a two-year period as long as the lifeguard is employed by the City of Quinter. Motion passed 5-0 *Retroactive Back to 2018.*


